

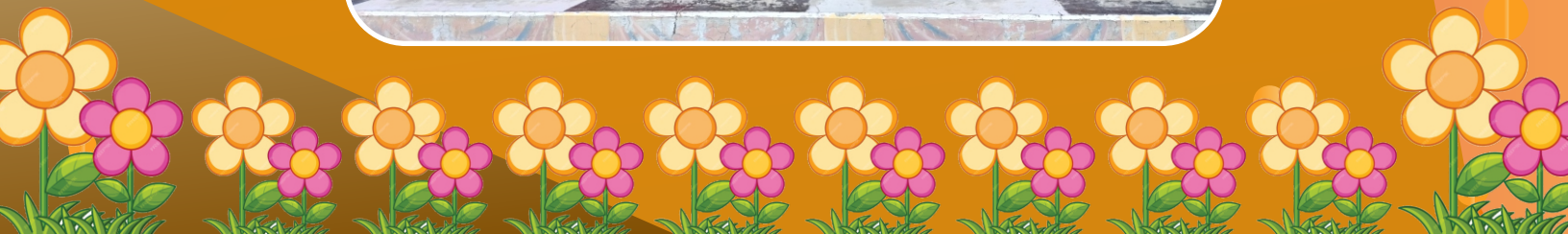

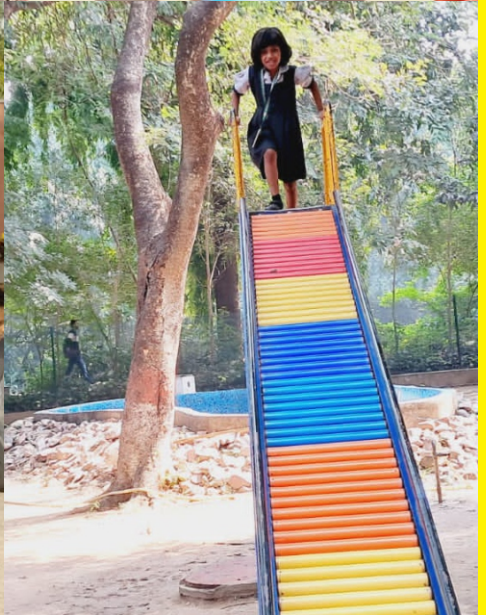






















Principal's Desk

Maharana Pratap

Maharana Pratap is counted on top ten strongest warrior ever born in India. He was the king of the Sisodia Rajput Dynasty of Mewar in Rajasthan. Pratap Singh was the thirteenth Maharana of Mewar known for his valiant and spirited defence against the Mughal Empire. He was one of the bravest Rajput ruler of India, who ruled Mewar for 35 years. While other Rajput rulers accepted the supremacy of Akbar. He was one of the few ruler in Indian history who stood firm against the mighty Mughal Empire.

This year marks the 482nd birth anniversary of Maharana Pratap. According to the English calendar, Maharana Pratap Jayanti falls on 9th May, but in the India, the warrior king's birth anniversary is celebrated as per the Hindu calendar on the tithi of Jyeshtha's shukla paksha, which falls on 2nd Jun. The day is observed as a public holiday in some states such as Rajasthan, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh.

Maharana Pratap was born on 9th May on 1540. Father name was Uday Singh and mother Jaiwanta bai. His younger brother were Shakti Singh, Vikram Singh and Jagmal Singh. Maharana Pratap was married to Ajabde Punwar of Bijolia.

Upon the death of Udai Singh in 1572 there was a brief tussle on who would succeed the throne of Mewar. Maharana Pratap had other step brothers who were also vying for the throne of Mewar. However the senior nobles in his father's court wanted Pratap Singh to succeed as he was the eldest son of Udai Singh. Thus Maharana Pratap took over the throne of Mewar's Royal family at the age of 32 on 1st March 1572.

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was the founder of the Maratha Empire in western India. He is considered to be one of the greatest warriors of his time. With his determination and great administrative skills Shivaji carved out an empire out of the declining Adilshahi Sultanate of Bijapur which eventually became the great Maratha Empire. Shivaji implemented an efficient and progressive administration with the help of a disciplined military and well established administrative setup. Shivaji was well known for his innovative military tactics based on non-conventional methods which took advantage of the like geography and speed. Since Sahaji spent most of his time outside of Pune the responsibility of overseeing Shivaji's education rested on the shoulders of a small council of ministers which included a Peshwa

(Shamarnikant) a Mazumdar (Balkrishna Pant) a Sabnis (Raghunath Ballal).
